



APPLICATION FOR SABBATICAL STATUS

ASA becomes even more important to members who take a sabbatical because it provides them with an opportunity for benefits they may not otherwise receive as well as access to information on issues affecting their profession. In an effort to provide a way for designated members to stay in touch with ASA without paying full membership dues, Resolution N14 was passed by the Board of Governors. Under this resolution, a member applying for sabbatical status must meet the following requirements:

- a) Member is not currently conducting appraisals, but expects to resume appraising in the near future.
- b) Individual has been a member has been in good standing for the last five (5) years.
- c) Member must attach a letter stating the reasons he/she is requesting Sabbatical status.

The member must also agree to the following conditions:

- a) Sabbatical status will not last for more than two (2) years.
- b) Member’s annual international dues will be reduced to \$150 while in Sabbatical status and it must be submitted with this application. The Member will continue to receive the ASA publications and benefits normally included in the cost of membership. Discipline journals are an optional purchase over and above the \$150 annual sabbatical fee.
- c) Member will not receive a membership card.
