It's as easy as One, Two, Three

### Step 1: Become a Candidate Member of ASA

- Pass ASA's Online Ethics Exam
- Pass USPAP Exam (if applicable) \*

*\*USPAP requirement may be met by providing a copy of your valid state RP license*

### Step 2: Provide SRA Documentation

- Provide your SRA designation certificate
- Provide a copy of your valid RP state license
- Complete the online accreditation application

---

### Step 3: International Board of Examiners Review

- Your completed application will be sent to a reviewer on ASA's International Board of Examiners for review
- Once that review has been completed and approved, you will be awarded your ASA designation
